



## Religion Outcomes: Kindergarten

### **1. Students will understand what it means to be responsible members of the Catholic Christian Community.**

Students will

- Learn how to get along as members of God's family;
- Learn to care for one another in a class setting;
- Experience a sense of belonging.

### **2. Students will participate in and understand the liturgical year, the sacramental celebrations and the ministries of the Catholic Church.**

Students will

- Learn about Baptism;
- Participate in masses and prayer services;
- Celebrate the seasons of Advent and Lent;
- Celebrate the special holy days of Christmas and Easter.

### **3. Students will learn to appreciate prayer in all of its forms and to make it a part of their lives.**

Students will

- Use simple petitions;
- Pray for one another's families and concerns;
- Use the classroom prayer corner as a special place of peace.

### **4. Students will learn to appreciate Scripture and to value its history and its meaning in today's world.**

Students will

- Learn that the Bible is a special book, containing the Word of God;
- Learn gospel stories about Jesus and his friends.

### **5. Students will learn to see service as a true sign of Faith in action and live the principles of Catholic Social Teaching.**

Students will

- Make cards for the sick;
- Share money and/or needed items with the poor;
- Show respect for one another and for all creation;
- Learn to be peacemakers.
